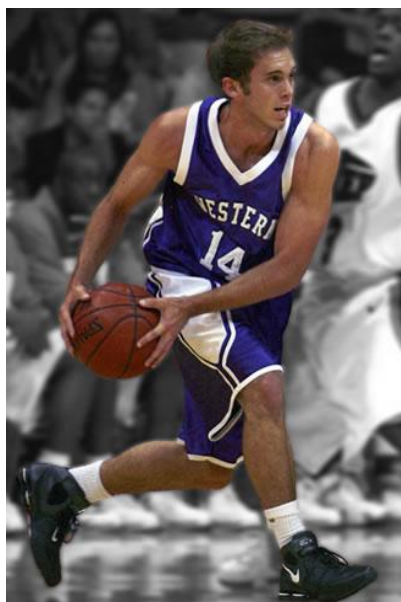

Trey can bring the ball up as a point guard and run the team, and can also come off screens and/or spot-up and be a tremendous scorer. Is also a very smart/tough defender. Is continuing to work on being a better penetrator, and finishing at the basket to be a complete offensive player.

Trey Clarkson finished his college career at Western New Mexico University leading his team in scoring the last two seasons. A four year starter as a combo guard, he played his first three years at the point guard position and played the shooting guard his senior season. Trey was named First Team Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference, leading the conference in three-point field goal percentage and three-point field goals made. The Western New Mexico Community voted Trey STUDENT ATHLETE OF THE YEAR in his senior season.
